Glaze by Today's Technology in Its Original Form" (State planning Organisation Advanced

Research Project; 2002-2005) gaining knowledges are used for some other projects. In 2011,

worked on a Project titled "Investigation of the Effect of Firing Process in Traditional Wood

Furnaces on Ceramic Bodies Containing Iron Oxide" together a master student, with Durcan

Atasoy, in Akköy.

In applications of the project, used from the samples of Akköy Period of Principalities glazed

ceramic sherds as they are determined precessors of Çanakkale Ceramics according to some

researcher's writings. With the help of some local Masters, supplying local raw materials

sources of Akköy, were included in the ceramic bodies, slips and glazes, and shaping artifacts

with the mediums had fired an old traditional woodfire kiln in there. Furthermore, same bodies

had also fired in an electric kiln and with a gas butane kiln to compare with the woodfire kiln

results.

All the project processes will be summarized through with textual and visual explanations on a

poster presentation at the symposium. It is considerable within the scope of Kilns, workshops
