REVISITING THE MEDIEVAL CERAMICS OF THE 1935-1948 GOZLUKULE EXCAVATIONS IN TARSUS (SOUTH TURKEY)

Representing one of the very few Abbasid sites in Turkey, this paper discusses the different classes of pottery found in the Gozlukule ceramic corpus uncovered on the Gozlukule mound in Tarsus (southern Turkey). It addresses two main issues: what are the characteristics of these ceramics and how do they compare to neighboring sites and those of the Islamic world? This paper offers an overview of the unpublished Medieval ceramics of the 1935-1948 Gozlukule excavations where new excavations resumed in 2001 with the collaborative efforts of Bogazici University (TR) and Bryn Mawr College (USA).
