POTTERY IN ANATOLIA AND THE EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN FROM THE 10TH TO 17TH CENTURIES

This communication will present new information on ceramics from two excavations: one at Torone in the coast of northern Greece and the other at Xanthos on the Lycian coast. Groups of ceramics will be considered from each site to cover the period c. AD 1000 to 1700. As well as presenting new types and providing new information about already-known types, a general summary of the evolution of ceramics through these centuries and their production in a historical context will be given.
